

## OFII RESIDENCE FORM (ENGLISH TRANSLATION)

Note: Complete the top, superior, section only. If your visa is granted, the Consulate will stamp this form and return it to you. You will then complete the last portion of the form upon your arrival in France, and send it to the closest local branch of the OFII.

Nom de Naissance: Last name

Prenom: First name

Nom D'Espouse: Spouse's name (leave blank unless married)

Sexe: Gender (check masculine or feminine)

Ne(s): Birthdate (enter in this format: Day/Month/Year, for example July 1, 1985 should be written 01/07/1985)

A: City/state of birth

Pays: Country of birth

Situation Familiale: Check one. Celibataire (single) ; Marie (married); veuf (widowed); Divorce (divorced); Separe (separated)

Filiation: Filiation/Lineage

Pere Nom: Father's last name

Prenom: Father's first name

Mere Nom de naissance: Mother's maiden name

Prenom: Mother's first name

Nationalite: Nationality

Passeport: Numero: passport number    Delivre le : Date of issue (enter in this format: Day/Month/Year)

A: Place of Issue of Passport

## IMPORTANT NOTES

- This process will take 4-7 weeks. Students should initiate the process as soon as they receive their official acceptance letter from the host institution.
- A notary is a public officer who certifies documentation. They can be found in banks, city government offices, law firms, and some libraries. You can find notaries near you by searching the Internet. Some documents may provide a designated area, but if there is no specific designation the notary may simply sign and place a stamp near the signer of the document. Be sure to know whether or not your consulate requires your documents to be notarized.
- Bring all required documentation together at the same time to your French Consulate appointment.
- You must submit your passport and immigration documents for the duration of processing time. You will not be able to travel internationally until after your visa is processed.
